TYPES OF CHILDCARE:

Registered Family Child Care Provider: A resident of a registered family child care home who is responsible for the children in care, is the children's primary caregiver, and whose name is on the certificate of registration.

Certified Child Care Center: a business caring for more than 13 children in a facility designed for that purpose. Centers employ staff & are subject to staff-child ratios and annual announced and unannounced inspections

Certified Child Care Group Home: A business caring for up to 12 children usually in the provider's home and subject to licensing requirements similar to centers.

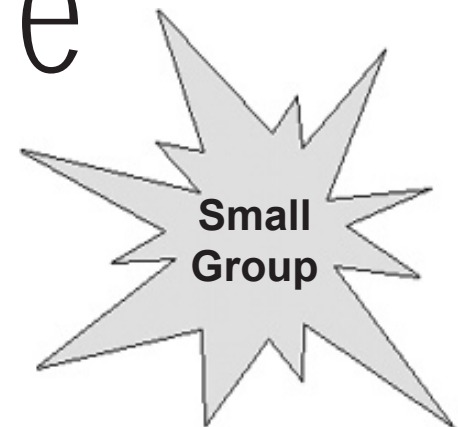
